## Do you have home repair and weatherization needs?

- **Weatherization Assistance Program:** Helps reduce energy costs for low-income individuals and higher-risk residents.
- **Owner-Occupied Rehabilitation Program:** Provides minor and major repairs to homes to address health and safety issues.
- **Nazareth Family Foundation:** Provides small repairs to owner-occupied homes that include water heaters, electric panels, wiring, replacing a door or a single window.
- **Whole Home Repair Program:** Provides funding for home repairs and accessibility modifications for low-income households.
