Be Informed, Be Empowered

A landlord who bans everyone with a criminal record may be violating the Fair Housing Act. If you think you've been treated unfairly, contact the Fair Housing agency listed below.



Tell Your Story

How long has it been since you committed a crime? What have you done since then? Are you working or trying to care for family? Get letters of support from your boss, pastor, or parole officer.



Know The Facts

Having a stable home helps people who were in prison avoid committing more crimes. As time goes by after their release and as they get older, they are less likely to get involved in crime.
